## Problem

- GNOME is a free desktop for UNIX
  - Composed of 2+ MLOCs
  - 6 years old
  - 500 regular contributors around the world
  - Many core contributors work for different companies
- How to organize themselves so they can accomplish the goals of the project?



## Approach/Solution

- Dependency on F/OS tools
- Work modularized to minimize communication
- Communication: mailing lists, icq, Web sites
- CVS maintains code
- Organization
  - Foundation
  - Maintainers
  - Core developers
- Administrative tasks assigned to volunteer committees
